Jesus Christ Superstar is not meant to be a religious or theological piece, but rather an interpretation of the final week of the life of Jesus of Nazareth, through the doubtful eyes of Judas Iscariot. The show explores themes of love, betrayal and sacrifice, while reimagining biblical events through modern musical expression.

The show emphasizes the humanity of its characters, portraying Jesus as a man grappling with his fate and expectations set upon his life, and the inner turmoil of Judas Iscariot who struggles with his feelings of right vs. wrong.
